## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Dwayne Nosie has come before the Tribal Council with an emergency request that the council grant approval for a land assignment site for him and his family in the Seven Mile area near his mother's home; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Nosie explains to the Council that his investigation indicates there will be no conflict with other land use or other tribal members in the area that he wants assigned to him as a homesite; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizing the emergency matter of Mr. Nosie's request agrees that his request should be granted prior to the Land Board's next meeting.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain
  Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a land assignment to Dwayne Nosie and his family for homesite
  purposes in the Seven Mile Community near his
  mother's present house.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that a copy of this resolution be filed with the Land Board Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6,1985, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
