## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Louise Fall, pursuant to Resolution No. 85-54, was granted her request that she be transferred from Development Enterprise back to the Central Tribal Office; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Fall, a tribal member, has again come before the Tribal Council with a complaint that the Administrative Manager refuses to place her back in the Central Tribe Computer Room and that she is now requesting Tribal Council assistance to require the Administrative Manager to return her to the Central Tribe Computer Room where she had previously been employed prior to her transfer to Development Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after some discussion, concludes that Resolution No. 85-54 should be amended to specify that Louise Fall be permitted to return to her former position in the Central Tribe Computer Room with all seniority and benefits to remain intact.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Administrative Manager of the Tribe to immediately reinstate Louise Fall into her former position in the Central Tribe Computer Room with all seniority and fringe benefits.

The foregoing resolution was on April 16, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
