RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has gone into Contract with the Development Enterprise of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to construct a Road Project FAIR 71(2) in the vicinity of Lower Bonito Bridge, and
- WHEREAS, the Development Enterprise requested to haul in subbase material to a stockpile instead of crushing the material on site, and
- WHEREAS, the Development Enterprise is requesting 2 sites for stockpiling subbase material (Sta. 97±00 Lt 200' x 200' and Sta 152+00 Lt 200' x 200') for the period of said Contract, and
- WHEREAS, the Development Enterprise will be responsible for the rehabilitation of said areas.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it hereby agrees to permit the Development Enterprise to use said areas for the purpose intended.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and 3 y-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Inverior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
