## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountian Apache Tribe has provided for the selection of an Tribal Engineer by the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Personnel Department has advertised for the position of Tribal Engineer and has accepted applications, and said applicants' resumes have been presented to the Tribal Council and.
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and interviewed applicants that meet the qualifications required for the position of Tribal Engineer of the White Mountian Apache Tribe.
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council understands that the salary and related expenses for the Tribal Engineer shall reimbursed by a BIA 638 Grant.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints E. Gene Riggs to the position of Tribal Engineer of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary shall be established at the rate of \$38,000 per annum.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the employee benefits shall be those as established through the Tribal Personnel Policies and Procedures.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountian Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 () of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
