RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by tribal members and from other sources that there exists a problem of hooking up water lines and water service to mobile homes on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, it is the Tribal Council policy to facilitate water service for all mobile homes on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, recommends that the Indian Health Service provide water hookups to ensure water service for all mobile homes reservation-wide.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Indian Health Service to provide water hookups for all mobile homes located on the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
