RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously received citizens complaints from the Seven-Mile Community that the water tank for that community is too small and is inadequate to serve the water needs for that community, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal (ouncil is advised that there may be larger water tanks available in the Bureau of Indian Affairs parking compound, in East Fork or in Cibecue and that appropriate officials should investigate which tank would be most feasible and available for immediate use in the Seven-Mile Community, and
- WHEREAS, after some discussions and because of the urgency on this matter, the Tribal Council concludes that West Anderson, the Acting Director of the Utility Authority, should be directed to locate a larger tank for the Seven-Mile Community; specifically, should investigate the feasibility and availability of the water tanks now located in the Bureau of Indian Affairs parking compound and in the East Fork and Cibecue communities and immediately install the appropriate tank at Seven Mile.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs West Anderson, the Acting Director of the Utility Authority to locate a larger tank for the Seven-Mile Community inorder to provide adequate water service to several families who have previously complained to the Council of the lack of water for their homes.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs Mr. Anderson to specifically look into the water tanks now abailable at the Bureau of Indian Affairs parking compound and in East Fork and Cibecue and make a determination which tank, if any, would be most feasible and immediately available for transfer to the Seven-Mile area for service to the households in need.

The foregoing resolution was on June 12, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
