## PESCLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Human Service Center for the White Mountain Apache Tribe has come before the Tribal Council with a request for Tribal Council approval to apply for a one-time funding grant to be awarded on a competitive basis to current grantees under Title VI of the Older Americans Act, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Human Service Center is presently a grantee, pursuant to Title VI of the Older Americans Act and is; therefore, eligible to apply for this one-time funding, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Human Service Center should immediately apply for this funding for the benefit of the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the White Mountain Apache Tribal Human Service Center to apply for the one-time funding to be awarded on a competitive basis to current grantees, of which the Human Service Center is one, under Title VI of the Older Americans Act.

The foregoing resolution was on June 12, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
