RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, pursuant to previous Trikal Council Resolution No. 85-71, the Tribal Council deleted funding for Tribal Council meetings from the 01 Budget, and
- WHEREAS, now that the budget process has been completed, a review of the 01 Budget indicates that sufficient budgetary restraints and allocations have been met, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it may be in the best interest for the administration of the Tribal Governing Body that monies previously allocated to the Tribal Council be restrored to the Ol Budget.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby restores the budgetary amount of \$30,000.00 to the Tribal Council Budget and; thereby, rescinds Resolution No. 85-71 to the extent that said resolution deleted said monies.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that all other provisions of said resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
