RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, some people who have HUD Homes and Rentals have not been paying their monthly charges, and

WHEREAS, there is a housing shortage on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, those who do not pay, jeopardize future and current construction of additional units, and

WHEREAS, some of those who have not paid are Tribal Employees.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that hereinafter, that any and all Tribal Employees who are behind payments more than two (2) months, be placed on mandatory payroll deduction by the Tribal Payroll Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Administrative Manager shall coordinate with the Tribal Housing Authority in carrying out the policy directive of the Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 20, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
