RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, on June 12, 1985, Resolution No. 85-132 was adopted by the Tribal Council granting permission to Betty Dillon to sponsor a Tribal Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for her daughter, and
- WHEREAS, inadvertently an error was made on the date of the resolution, and
- WHEREAS, the date of the occasion should have been August 9, 10, and 11, 1985; not September 9, 10, and 11, 1985 as the Resolution stated.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 85-132 by changing the date of September 9, 10, and 11, 1985 to August 9, 10, and 11, 1985.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 85-132 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1985, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
