RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has accepted a HUD Community Development Block Grant to construct a low density feed lot, and
- WHEREAS, various feedlot sites have proven unsuitable due to lack of water, power or other site requirements, and community concern regarding potential environmental disadvantages, and
- WHEREAS, continuous and diligent study has indicated that the only remaining feasible siting possibility is at the Industrial Park area.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the siting of the HUD funded feedlot in the southwestern area of the Industrial Park.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that the details of siting and the construction of the feedlot commence immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on August 07, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
