## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has been determined that the current FY 85 HIP Contract has been extended through March 31, 1986, and
- WHEREAS, Bureau of Indian Affairs Area Office has approved a final allotment in the amount of \$9,437.88 which is uncommitted money and has been applied to the general construction line item, and
- WHERFAS, Linda Tani, J.T.P.A. Director who is responsible for building these homes anticipates a substantial savings as contract expenditues are running below budgeted cost, and
- WHEREAS, the combination of J.T.P.A. savings in the approximate amount of \$15,000.00 and the HIP final allotment of \$9,437.88, and
- WHEPHAS, Councilman Herbert Tate's selected recipient for a FY 35 HIP home was Sarah Massey, but due to federal program cuts Sarah Massey was made an alternate on the contract, and
- WHEREAS, a very serious need exists for decent, safe and sanitary housing for Sarah Massey and her family and this is a priority.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Sarah Massey be awarded the HIP home under the present FY 85 HIP Contract which expires March 31, 1985.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that J.T.P.A. in conjunction with the Vocational Skill Center build this home within the time alloted this contract but no later than March 31, 1986.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (43 Stat. 984).
