RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise has previously entered into a 638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct a survey of Elk habitat, population, and grazing habits on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise is requested to apply to renew said contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for FY 85/86 in order to continue the Elk Study, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise is requesting Tribal Council authorization to renew said contract, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the contract should be renewed as it benefits the wildlife and heritage of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the White Mountain Apache Recreation Enterprise to renew the 638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the continuation of the Elk Study on the reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman and the Director of the Recreation Enterprise to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
