WHEREAS, Mrs. Wenona Lupe has come before the Tribal Council requesting permission of the Tribal Council to allow her family to sponsor a Tribal Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for her daughter on the weekend of September 7, 1985, and

WHEREAS, the necessary ceremonies and arrangements will take place in the family farmland in the East Fork Community.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the family of Mrs. Wenona Lupe to sponsor a Tribal Ceremonial Sunrise Dance on the weekend of September 7, 1985 in the East Fork Community.

The foregoing resolution was on August 27, 1958 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
