RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by the Sunrise Ski Area Business Manager that there is a great need to pave the Sunrise Hotel Parking lot and its driveway prior to the 1985/86 ski season, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that the Fort Apache Indian Agency-Bia can initiate action pursuant to Tribal Council request to add the Hotel Parking lot and driveway to the Bia Road System and complete the paving necessary before the ski season.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency to initiate the necessary action to incorporate the Sunrise Hotel Parking lot and driveway into the Bia Road System and further, requests that the paving of the parking lot and driveway be completed prior to the advent of the ski season.
- BE IT FURIHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that the Superintendent utilize Bia road funds for this purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on August 27, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
