## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Fred Aday, a member of the General Livestock Board of Directors, has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of the General Livestock Association and has requested assistance in the form of labor to take down the fence and wire on the land across from the airport for reuse in other areas, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Aday explains that the General Livestock Association does not have the finances to employ laborers for that purpose and; therefore, respectfully requests that the Tribal Council authorize TWEP workers to provide the labor.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the TWEP Department to utilize TWEP workers to assist the General Livestock Association in the removal of the fence wire from the land across the highway from the airport.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that the TWEP Director, Adam Lupe, and Social Services Director, Roslyn Mike, and Fred Aday of the General Livestock Association meet and coordinate the use of the TWEP employees for the above-stated purpose within the permissible guidelines.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
