RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has advertised publicly for applicants to fill the position of Tribal Utility Authority Manager, and
- WHEREAS, the Council has interviewed the top applicants, one of whom was Mr. William J. Park of Vernon, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Park has extensive experience in water and sewer construction and water company management, and
- WHEREAS, the Council concludes that Mr. Park is the most qualified for the position of Tribal Utility Authority Manager.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. William J. Park to the position of Tribal Utility Authority Manager.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Mr. Park is requested to meet with the Tribal Personnel Department for appropriate personnel processing, establishment of salary, fringe benefits, and for the commencement date of his job responsibilities.

The foregoing resolution was on September 25, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
