RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Ms. Zella (Danford) Yardley came before the Tribal Council complaining that for over three years she has been waiting for a house for her family and their need for a decent shelter is greater now than ever before, and
- WHEREAS, she further requested that she would like to apply under the Home Improvement Program rather than the Ram-Earth Project that is still in the planning stage.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Zella (Danford) Yardley to be placed on the Home Improvement Housing Program; thereby, removing her name from the Ram-Earth Housing Project at her own request.

The foregoing resolution was on October 02, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
