RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Planning Office has procured in excess of one million dollars for the Tribe in the current Tribal fiscal year; and
- WHEREAS, the paperwork to apply for such grants incurs extraordinary photocopying and office supply expenses; and
- WHEREAS, the present budget is not adequate to cover said costs.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the planning department budget for the current fiscal year be increased by \$7,500 to cover the additional office expense.

The foregoing resolution was on October 2, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
