
RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that the National Congress of American Indians will hold its annual convention from October 7, 1985 through October 11, 1985, in Tulsa, Oklahoma; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmembers, Gertie Lupe, Marjorie Grimes, Lafe Altaha, Carlos Nosie and Alvino Hawkins have been delegated to represent the White Mountain Apache Tribe at the National Congress of American Indians Annual Convention; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement of the importance of the Convention and that the White Mountain Apache Tribe should be represented at the conference; and
- WHEREAS, Councilman, Raymond Endfield, Jr. has informed the Tribal Council that he should attend the Hotel Management Seminar in Kaneeta because of the benefits he could bring back to Sunrise from the seminar materials and presentations; and
- WHEREAS, Raymond Endfield, Jr. has further informed the Tribal Council that most of the expenses to attend the Hotel Management Seminar will be paid by the CORNELL UNIVERSITY; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the Sunrise operations can benefit from Mr. Endfield's attendance at the Hotel Management Seminar.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves the appropriation of budgeted funds for the above named Tribal Council Members to attend the National Congress of American Indians Annual Convention, provided that expenditures are within the tribal travel guidelines for Tribal Council Members.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves the appropriation of budgeted funds for the remaining costs of Councilman Raymond Endfield, Jr. to attend the Hotel Management Seminar in Kaneeta of approximately \$610.50.

The foregoing resolution was on October 2, 1985, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
