BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Mrs. Altaha's request to sponsor a Tribal Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for her daughter during the weekend of April 25, 26, 27, 1986 in Whiteriver with Co-sponsors, Emily and Henry White, Jr. of East Fork.

The foregoing resolution was on October 2, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
