RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilman Lafe Altaha has requested Revenue Sharing Funds in order to repair a Head Start Van equipped for the Handicapped Program, and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Federal Revenue Sharing Guidelines, there must be three public meetings prior to authorizing the release of Revenue Sharing Funds for permissible expenditures, and
- WHEREAS, this meeting shall constitute the second public meeting, of which prior notice has been given to the public, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council takes notice that no opposition has been received to date from the general public or at this meeting to the use of Revenue Sharing Funds for repairs to the van used to transport handicapped children.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby gives notice that the required second public meeting has been held this date in regards to a request for the use of Revenue Sharing Funds to repair the van used for the transportation of handicapped children.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby gives notice that there has been no opposition received to the use of Revenue Sharing Funds for this purpose at this second publicly announced meeting.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs that a third and final public meeting be set for the next regularly scheduled Council Meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on October 24, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
