## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the East Fork Community is still suffering from a lack of adequate water pressure and water service to their homes, and
- WHEREAS, the new Utility Authority Director has advised the Tribal Council that he has located water tanks which can be utilized for the community, but that adequate funding is not available for him to correct the problem, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Parks should meet with Dick Byerly from Indian Health Service; as well as, the Tribal Administrative Manager in order to obtain the necessary funding to complete the necessary water service modifications because of the health hazard posed by the inadequate water supply to East Fork Community homes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Mr. Parks, Director of the Utility Authority, to immediately commence the necessary water service modifications so as to provide an adequate supply of water to the appropriate homes in the East Fork Community.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Mr. Parks is instructed to contact the Tribal Business Administrative Manager and Dick Byerly, of the Indian Health Service in order to obtain the necessary funding. labor and materials necessary to complete these repairs and modifications in the most expeditious manner possible.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that upon completion of the necessary repairs, Mr. Parks is to report to the Office of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman the date of completion.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
