RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by the Sunrise Ski Area Business Manager that there is a great need to patch and maintain the 0.14 mile turnout to the Sunrise Hotel Parking Lot prior to the 1985/86 ski season, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that the Bureau of Indian Affairs can initiate action in accordance with Tribal Council Resolution to add the aforementioned turnout to the Sunrise Hotel Complex Parking Lot to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Road system for the purpose of road maintenance.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Fort Apache Indian Agency Superintendent and Agency Road Engineer initiate the necessary action to incorporate the turnout from State Route 273, 0.14 mile to the Hotel Parking Lot into the Bureau of Indian Affairs Road System and further requests that the patching of this turnout be completed prior to the advent of the season ski activity.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
