RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Lafe Altaha, by prior notice to the public has designated the date and meeting as the third and final hearing on the use of Revenue Sharing Funds to repair the Head Start van which is used to transport handicapped children on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council takes notice that to date there has been no public opposition to the use of Revenue Sharing Funds to repair the van for the transportation of handicapped children, and
- WHEFFAS, the Tribal Council states that all Revenue Sharing Guidelines have been complied with and that this is the third and final public hearing as required under Revenue Sharing Guidelines.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the disbursement of Fevenue Sharing Funds for the purpose of repairing the Head Start van for the transportation of handicapped children on the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on November 12, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
