RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Dennis Massey, Sr., a tribal member, has come before the Tribal Council for assistance in regards to a Game and Fish citation he received from the San Carlos Game Rangers, and
- WHEREAS, he advises the Tribal Council that he merely drove to San Carlos for the purpose of retrieving a horse and that he did not violate any San Carlos Game and Fishing laws, and
- WHEREAS, he states he was ordered to pay a fine which he believes is unjustified as he was on a public access Bureau of Indian Affairs Road, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Tribal Chairman should contact the Chairman of the San Carlos Apache Tribe to determine why the citation was issued and attempt to obtain a refund of any money paid as a fine by Dennis Massey, Sr.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Tribal Chairman, Ronnie Lupe, contact Tribal Chairman, Ned Anderson of the San Carlos Apache Tribe for the purpose of resolving the Game and Fish citation unjustifiably issued by the San Carlos Game Rangers to Mr. Dennis Massey, Sr., and; if possible, to obtain a refund of any fine paid by Mr. Dennis Massey, Sr.

The foregoing resolution was on November 12, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
