RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Rowena Jones, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has come before the Tribal Council with a request for Tribal Council approval of a land assignment comprising three (3) commercial lots in Hondah, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there are no conflicts or claims in the area of the commercial lots that she has requested be assigned to her for commercial purposes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the assignment to Mrs. Rowena Jones of three (3) commercial lots in the Hondah area according to the attached map provided by Mrs. Jones which is incorporated by reference herein.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that Mrs. Jones provide the Tribal Land Office with a copy of her lot map so that the proper metes and bounds description of the property assigned to her can be determined by that Office.

The foregoing resolution was on December 4, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
