## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Verna (Quintero) Apachito and her son, Carson Zahgotah have come before the Tribal Council and advised the Council that they are both handicapped and are in great need for comfortable homes, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Apachito further informs the Council that she is not well and is under constant medical care and cannot take care of herself or her family, is presently living with her parents under crowded circumstances and further, her mother is not well also, and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Apachito requests that a HIP home be built for her, and
- WHEREAS, she further request that a house be specially constructed for her son who is confined to a wheelchair, and
- WHEREAS, the Council representative for Mrs. Apachito advises her that she has already been placed on the list for a HIP home and that a home may be constructed for her son Carson Zahgotah possibly pursuant to handicap funds under Lafe Altaha's program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms that the HIP Program place Verna (Quintero) Apachito on a priority list for a home due to her handicap and present living conditions.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council that it hereby requests that Lafe Altaha, the Director of the Handicap Housing Fund Program, investigate the needs of Carson Zahgotah to determine Mr. Zahgotah's eligibility and possible sources of funding to construct a house suitable for his particular handicap.

The foregoing resolution was on December 19, 1985 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
