

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has been advised that the Indian Health Service wishes to donate to the tribe seven mobile homes located in Whiteriver, in the upper BIA compound, and located on lots assigned to the I.H.S. by the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS the Indian Health Service will not require the tribe to remove the donated mobile homes from the I.H.S. lots; and

WHEREAS the Tribal Council is acutely aware of the current housing shortage on the reservation; and

WHEREAS the Tribal Council recognizes that the mobile homes are in need of certain repairs and it being understood by the Tribal Council that the I.H.S. will not perform these repairs but that such repairs will be the responsibility of the tribe; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council does hereby accept the donation by the IHS of the seven mobile homes located in the upper BIA compound in Whiteriver and designated as follows:

1. One double-wide mobile home No. 1861.
2. One double-wide mobile home No. 1859.
3. One double-wide mobile home No. 1858 or 1860.
4. One single-wide mobile home No. 1862.
5. One single-wide mobile home No. 1863.
6. One single-wide mobile home No. 1864.
7. One single-wide mobile home No. 4.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this donation is accepted with the understanding that the tribe is under no obligation to reimburse the I.H.S. for the cost of the mobile homes, and that said donation is a gift to the tribe by the I.H.S., and upon the understanding that the tribe will not be required by the IHS to remove the mobile home from the lots upon which they are presently situated, and it being understood by the Tribal Council that any repairs to the mobile homes will be performed by the tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby directs the Tribal Maintenance Department to perform the necessary repairs upon the donated mobile homes and to expend such funds from its budget as may be necessary to perform the repairs but not to exceed its budget by an amount greater than that necessary to perform the repairs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Maintenance Department is hereby directed to administer the maintenance and rental of the mobil homes pursuant to its existing authority over tribally owned housing.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
