WHEREAS, Leroy Lupe, Director of the tribal Employee Rights Office, has reported to the Tribal Council that there are many personnel problems at the Sunrise Ski Resort involving certain non-member personnel and tribal members, and


WHEREAS, after a detailed discussion of some of the problems existing at the Sunrise Hotel, the Tribal Council concludes that a high level meeting should be held as soon as possible with Sunrise Management regarding these personnel problems, and that the Sunrise Board of Directors; Ron Malfara, General Manager; Joe Capretto, Manager of the Food and Beverage Department in the Sunrise Hotel; Bill London and Nancy Conway, Assistant Managers of the Sunrise Hotel should be present at said meeting with the complaining employees.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the aforementioned persons employed by the Sunrise Ski Resort present themselves before the Tribal Council at a time to be announced by the Chairman's Office for the purpose of discussing in detail personnel and management issues involving the Sunrise Ski Resort and in particular, the Sunrise Hotel.

The foregoing resolution was on January 14, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
