

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution, approved a contract for the employment of M. Deene Stowell as an expert consultant in the area of forestry resources, soils, logging practices, sawmill operation, hydrology and other resources; and

WHEREAS, said contract, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, expired on December 31, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to extend this contract for a period of one year effective December 31, 1985, unless sooner terminated, as provided in Paragraph 6 thereof; and

WHEREAS, the extension of said contract for one year will not entail any additional cost to the White Mountain Apache Tribe and that there are unexpended monies from the original contract still available to pay Mr. Stowell.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends the Expert Consultant Contract of M. Deene Stowell for a period of one year effective December 31, 1985, to terminate on December 31, 1986, unless sooner terminated as provided in paragraph 6 thereof.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Chairman, and in his absence the Vice Chairman, to execute any and all documents necessary to extend the above contract.

The foregoing resolution was on January 23, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a,f,i&k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe

June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
