

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Chair Person for the Land Board that it is necessary to update and revise regulations for business site applications as well as to modify the application form for homesites; and

WHEREAS, the Land Board requests that the Tribal Council direct the Tribal Attorney to draft proposed revisions of the homesite application form and to draft regulations for business site applications for Tribal Council and Land Board review and study.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Attorney's Office to draft business site regulations and a revision of the application form for homesites for Land Board and Tribal Council study.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (m&i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
