RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Betty Jean Bateman has requested Tribal Council approval of her homesite application which has previously been approved by the Tribal Land Board; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Mrs. Bateman's children are non-members of the tribe and therefore, cannot inherit Mrs. Bateman's rights to the homesite requested; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council being advised that there are no conflicting claims to the homesite and that Mrs. Bateman's request should be approved.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the homesite application made to the Tribe by Mrs. Betty Jean Bateman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said homesite approval shall only be valid during the lifetime of Mrs. Betty Jean Bateman and thereafter, shall revert to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for reassignment.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
