

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Safety Director that trash disposition, trash pickup and lack of an adequate landfill is causing problems for waste disposal; and

WHEREAS, it is suggested that the Tribal Safety Director and Tribal Work Experience Program pursue a plan for trash pickup and removal and to propose a land fill plan for waste disposal.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Tribal Safety Director and Tribal Work Experience Program to investigate and prepare a means by which trash can be picked-up on a regular basis in reservation communities for final disposal at an appropriate land fill area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it recommends to the Safety Director and Tribal Work Experience Program that they seek the assistance of the Fort Apache Indian Agency to clean up existing land fills and assist in proposing a means for trash pickup and disposal.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
