RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Lutheran World Mission Church wishes to donate \$3700.00 to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the purpose of paying laboratory fees for dentures for tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Tribal Health Authority administer these funds to ensure that they are used for the purpose designated by the Lutheran World Mission Church.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Health Authority to accept the donation of \$3700.00 from the Lutheran World Mission Church for the purpose of paying laboratory fees for dentures for tribal members.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby expresses its appreciation to the congregation of the Lutheran World Mission Church for its generous contribution to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
