RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is a Federally recognized Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25 USC, Section 476, and
- WHEREAS, the First Nations Financial Project is seeing individual applicants for a master's program in private and public management, and
- WHEREAS, the First Nations Financial Project is also seeking a compatible project field site for respective applicants, and
- WHEREAS, a primary goal for First Nations Financial Project is to design a plan for economic development that leads jtoward Tribal Self-sufficiency.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby supports Marilyn Rose Endfield, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as an applicant for the First Nations Financial Project.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires and agrees to be a field site of the First Nations Financial Project.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the White Mountain Apache Tribe will provide Marilyn Rose Endfield, with any/all resources necessary to carry out research of a case study of the Tribe's economy.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe will cooperate fully with Marilyn Rose Endfield, to design a blueprint plan for economic development towards Tribal self-sufficiency; in that, the Tribe will employ Marilyn Rose Endfield during the third and final year of the project, pursuant to terms to be developed and mutually agreed upon.

The foregoing resolution was on March 11, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
