


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are many tribal members employed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Indian Health Service who are eligible to vote in the 1986 Tribal Election to take place on April 02, 1986, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it is imperative that tribal members who are Bureau of Indian Affairs employees or employees of the Indian Health Service, should be allowed ample time to exercise their right to vote on April 02, 1986 and that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency and Director of the Indian Health Service Hospital should freely allow tribal-member employees time off to vote.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council requests that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency and the Director of the Indian Health Service Hospital provide their tribal-member employees with ample time on April 02, 1986 so that they can exercise their right to vote that day.

The foregoing resolution was on March 11, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
