

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that the late Mr. M. D. van Fredenberg, Jr. expressed as one of his last wishes that he be buried in the Whiteriver Cemetery on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to his request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the family of the late M. D. van Fredenberg, Jr. to lay the early body of Mr. van Fredenberg to rest in the Whiteriver Cemetery on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on March 11, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
