

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Roads Committee that Leslie Walker, has recently retired from the Bureau of Indian Affairs as a Heavy Equipment Operator for medical reasons; thereby, creating a vacancy in that position, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that a qualified tribal member be appointed to said position on a preferential basis.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Superintendent advertise the position of Heavy Equipment Operator recently vacated by Leslie Walker's retirement and that a qualified tribal member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be give hiring preference for that position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency include the Tribal Roads Committee in the selection process for this position.

The foregoing resolution was on March 11, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
