

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has revised their Right-of-Way requirements for Route No. 58, Sunrise Ski Area Road resurfacing, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to extend the existing Right-of-Way on the left side of the roadway; 25 feet in width, from highway station 25±00, a distance of 9.777 miles; from thence, 50 feet in width, from highway station 66±00, a distance of 0.076 miles; from thence 25 feet in width from highway station 70±00, a distance of 0.871 miles.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants to the Bureau of Indian Affairs an extension of the existing Right-of-Way as described herein and recorded on a map on file in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona, to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on March 12, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
