

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Administrative Business Manager advises the Tribal Council that trash containers for the Utility Authority necessary to fulfill a trash pickup contract with the Indian Health Service will require an amendment to the capital expense budget for Utility Authority in the amount of \$9,000.00; and


WHEREAS, after some discussion, the Tribal Council agrees to authorize the Tribal Business Office to expend \$9,000.00 to pay for said containers.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Administrative Business Manager to expend \$9,000.00 for the payment of trash containers purchased by the Tribal Utility Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes this capital purchase not previously included in the Fiscal Year 86/86 Tribal Utility Authority Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 5 for, 1 against and 2 abstentions, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
