RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a Council Member vacancy exists in District III as a result of

 Council member Alvino Hawkins' election to the position of Tribal

 Council Vice-Chairman; and
- WHEREAC, pursuant to the constitutional powers of the Tribal Council, the

 Council has the authority to appoint a successor to fill the

 position of District III Councilman for the remaining term of
 that office; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the communities comprising

 District III are in favor of the appointment of Mr. Darvin Burnette

 to complete the term of office for the District III seat vacated

 by Mr. Hawkins; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council after discussion of the widespread community support for Mr. Burnette concludes that Mr. Burnette meets the qualifications of office and that his appointment as District III Councilman for the remainder of the term should be approved.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Darvin Burnette to the position of District III Councilman for the remainder of the term of said office.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IX, Section 3, and Article V, Section 1 (u) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1934 (Stat. 984).
