RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Tribal Attorney that the Tribe has been awarded a grant pursuant to the Justice Assistance Act of 1984, Block Grant Program which is administered by Arizona Department of Public Safety, and
- WHEREAS, the grant awarded to the Tribe is in the amount of \$14,088.00 for a Victim-Witness Program that enables citizens and police to undertake initiatives to prevent and control neighborhood crime, and
- WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed budget summary is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council directs that said funds shall be utilized within the existing Juvenile Court System.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts and approves the 1984 block grant award from the Arizona Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$14,088.00 according to the budget summary attached hereto.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said funds shall be utilized in the existing Juvenile Court Program.

The foregoing resolution was on April 16, 1986 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
