

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Joe Joplin appearing on behalf of himself and his wife, Karen, both of whom are tribal members, have requested Tribal Council approval to renovate and lease the Cedar Creek Trading Post; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Joplin explains to the Tribal Council that he proposes to renovate the Cedar Creek Trading Post and has financial backing to accomplish the renovation; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Joplin is advised to meet with the Tribal Attorney so that he is in compliance with applicable Federal regulations and tribal requirements for a lease of tribal land.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Mr. Joplin's proposal to reopen the Cedar Creek Trading Post pursuant to a lease drafted in conformity with Federal Laws and Tribal regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Mr. Joplin shall be permitted to lease the buildings and land adjacent thereto, including the corraled and fenced-in area comprising the former Cedar Creek Trading Post grounds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the lease terms shall be subject to Tribal Council approval.

The foregoing resolution was on April 25, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
