

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised by the Head Start Program, that funding is available through the State of Arizona for Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention and Treatment on Indian Reservations and that the Head Start Program has been approved for funding, but that it is required that a written contract between the Tribe and the State Department of Economic Security be entered into setting forth the respective rights and responsibilities of each party thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed contract, as presented, a copy of which is attached hereto, and by reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves of said contract, for the purpose of meeting social services needs of Head Start children and families and to receive other benefits authorized thereunder.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the Tribal Chairman and in his absence the Vice Chairman to execute the Tribal Government Intergovernmental Agreement, hereinabove referenced and attached hereto, between the Tribe and the Arizona Department of Economic Security for the contract term of July 1, 1986 to June 30, 1987

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the execution of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of the Sovereign Immunity of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for any purpose.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 15, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

TRIBAL GOVERNMENT INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

Contract between the Department of Economic Security (the "Department") and
White Mountain Apache Tribe (the "Provider").

WHEREAS the Department is duly authorized to execute and administer contracts under A.R.S. § 41-1954.1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS the Provider is duly authorized to execute and administer contracts under White Mountain Apache
Tribal Council Resolution ; and

WHEREAS the Department and the Provider are authorized by A.R.S. §11-951 *et seq.* to enter into agreements for the joint exercise of any power common to the contracting parties as to governmental functions necessary to the public health, safety and welfare, and the proprietary functions of such public agencies; and

WHEREAS the Department desires that the Provider deliver services and the Provider has agreed to deliver services pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein;

THEREFORE the Department and Provider agree to abide by all the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract.

This document, its annexes, appendices and attachments, including any subcontracts, amendments and modifications approved under Sections 3.04 and 4.03 of these General Provisions, shall constitute the entire Contract between the parties, and supersede all other understandings, oral or written.
