

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Chairman Reno Johnson has requested Tribal Council authorization to renovate the Office of Chairman, specifically for drapes, carpeting and furniture necessary for the functioning of the Office; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed estimates submitted from the Architect and Engineering Department as well as other sources as to the costs of repairing and renovating the Chairman's Office for occupancy and use and that said estimates approximate \$50,000; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that monies may be available in the Tribal Contingency account to fund the renovation and furnishing of the Chairman's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the office is in great need of renovation and that the office desk was removed pursuant to prior Resolution 86-103 and that replacements must be ordered as soon as possible so that the office can conduct tribal business immediately.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the appropriation of not more than \$50,000 from the Tribal Contingency fund for the purpose of renovating and furnishing the Tribal Chairman's Office.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
