

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Linda Tani, the Director of the Tribal J.T.P.A. has resigned from her position thereby creating a need to appoint an Acting Director pending formal advertisement for said position; and


WHEREAS, Mrs. Marjorie Quade, an employee of the JTPA office is recommended to the Council as being qualified to perform the duties as Acting Director pending advertisement for said position; and

WHEREAS, it is also recommended that an audit be conducted of the program operations immediately prior to appointment of a new Director.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Marjorie Quade as Acting Director of the Tribal JTPA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal business office to arrange for an immediate audit of the JTPA program prior to the appointment of a permanent Director for the program.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
