

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has recognized housing access roads to be of a high priority, Resolution 84-14; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of-way, 80 feet in width for a distance of 1.281 miles in length for Route No. 1 - W. Quintero and Diamond Creek Housing Roads as filed (Drawing No. FA-1-6) in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency; Whiteriver, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of-way, 40 feet in width for a distance of 0.228 miles and 60 feet in width for a distance of 0.857 mile or a total distance of 1.085 miles on Routes 4 and 47 - Bruce Antonio Drive, Reno Johnson Drive, Theodore Declay Drive, Snake Eye Drive, and Bear Canyon Drive as filed (Drawing No. FA-48, 47-3) in the office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency; Whiteriver, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of-way, 50 feet in width for a distance of 0.103 miles, 55 feet in width for a distance of 0.200 mile and 65 feet in width for a distance of 0.095 mile or a total distance of 0.398 mile on Route 7 - East Fork Mission Roads as filed (Drawing No. FA-7-2) in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency; Whiteriver, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of-way, 60 feet in width for a distance of 0.431 mile on Route 5 - Carrizo as filed (Drawing No. FA-5-1) in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency; Whiteriver, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of way, 60 feet in width for a distance of 0.786 mile and 80 feet in width for a distance of 0.227 mile for a total distance of 1.013 miles on Route 7 - Rodeo Road, Massey Road, Adley Road and Bush Flats Road as filed (Drawing No. FA-7-1) in the Office of the Superintendent of Fort Apache Agency; Whiteriver, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant gratuitous right-of-way, 60 feet in width for a distance of 1.132 miles - Route 1 (Yucca Flats); 60 feet in width for a distance of 0.848 mile - Route 1 (Beanpot Road and Lake Shore Drive); 40 feet in width for a distance of 0.189 mile and 50 feet in width for a distance of 0.563 for a total of 0.752 mile Route 1 (Jack's Road, Cementary Road, and Graveyard Road) as filed (Drawing No. FA-1-7; FA-1-8; FA-1-9) in the Office of the Superintendent of Fort Apache Agency; Whiteriver, Arizona.





The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
