


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs intends to combine under the Fort Apache Indian Agency's Facilities Management Director responsibility to administer both the Fort Apache Agency's and San Carlos Agency's Facilities Management Department; and

WHEREAS, combining those responsibilities under one Director will result in a drastic reduction in the quality and quantity of services by the Director of Facilities Management to the White Mountain Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby opposes the proposed reduction and services made by the Phoenix Area Office by placing the San Carlos and Fort Apache Indian Agencies Facilities Management Program under one Director and hereby requests the Phoenix Area Office to maintain the Directorship for Facilities Management solely at the Fort Apache Indian Agency in order to fulfill the responsibilities of the Bureau to the White Mountain Apache Tribe without a decrease in services.

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
