

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Josephine Gooday, a Tribal Member residing in Carrizo has come before the Tribal Council requesting approval from the Tribal Council for the use of Land Claims funds of the Carrizo Community for train transportation, room and board for five students from Carrizo for a trip to Disneyland; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that such a trip may provide a valuable learning experience for those eighth graders, none of whom has the financial means to meet the expenses of the trip on their own; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council that there is community support and approval to utilize these funds for said purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the use of Carrizo Land Claims funds in the amount of \$150.00 per student to be used for train transportation, room and board for the students Disneyland trip.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
